North Cedar Elementary Boosters met on February 6th, 2023 in the Jr/Sr High Library. The meeting was led by President, Nicki Welch. The group read the mission statement to begin their meeting.

The minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed. Melissa Armstrong shared the treasurer's report. A discussion was had around the revenue and expenses the Elementary Boosters had in the previous month. The biggest expenses and revenue came from the Father/Daughter dance held on February 11. The total expense for the event was \$691.65. The total revenue from the event was \$1630.00. Our current balance is now \$6,946.05.

Discussion of events each subcommittee has been focusing on was up next on the agenda. The fundraising committee and Elementary Boosters decided to move the Walk-A-Thon to September 2023 instead of this spring. This will allow more time for planning and ensure there are no conflicts with other end-of-the-year events at the elementary. The community committee discussed the overwhelming success of the Daddy/Daughter Dance. Next, began the discussion to set up a meeting with the community committee to plan details for the Mother/Son event scheduled for April 15th. Nicki Welch will send an email out to the committee members to plan this. The school committee scheduled a meeting to get together at a separate date to finalize plans for the Cabin Fever event. A date of April 28th was confirmed for the event. Finally, the staff committee shared their plans for a meal for the elementary teachers on Tuesday night during Parent Teacher conferences. A \$200 budget was given for the meal.
