Our **Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports** system will continue. We have moved away from digital ticketing and will be using actual tickets for students now to have when they receive positive reinforcement for behaviors that fit the PBIS criteria.

The goal of our **Multi-Tiered System of Supports** is to provide students with extra support to ensure that all students are being provided opportunities to succeed. This program will continue at the 7-12 building this year.
