The sale of these tickets help offset the costs of equipment, uniforms, and supplies used in the athletic program. The ticket, valid for the current school year, serves as a season pass for the student to attend all regular season home sports events. Students simply present their activity ticket to the ticket takers at the sporting event to gain admission. However, it cannot be used at music or drama events, as these activities do not receive any revenue from the sale of activity tickets.

A second option is to purchase a "Family Pass" for \$175. The form for Family Passes are available on the website or from the building secretary. Activity passes will be distributed at the start of school.
